National Disability Survey Results and Launch of a New Club Award

In August 2014, the Bowls Development Alliance, in conjunction with Bowls England and the English Indoor Bowling Association, launched a National Disability Survey to develop a greater understanding of the current and future opportunities that existed for disabled bowlers and which clubs currently have disabled bowlers using their facilities.

Today, ten weeks on, the Bowls Development Alliance are delighted to publish the National Disability Survey Report, which summaries the key findings of the survey. A number of key insights have resulted from the survey which will greatly assist the sport in its pursuit of attracting more disabled people into bowls.

One of the five key recommendations of the report was to create and launch an award which recognised those clubs and other organisations already working with disabled bowlers.

It is with great pleasure that alongside the publishing of the National Disability Survey Report, the Bowls Development Alliance can announce the launch of the **Love Fisher Brown Award**, sponsored by AeroBowls. This award, named after the remarkable and inspiring Commonwealth Games achievements of Bob Love, David Fisher and Paul Brown, is an opportunity to recognise and promote the great work of many clubs and organisations who already provide participation opportunities for disabled bowlers.
