Press Release – 03/10/2012 – Launch of New Level 2 Qualification in Coaching Bowls Start of Release --

The Bowls Development Alliance is pleased to announce the launch of the new Level 2 Qualification in Coaching Bowls. This is the first *ever* qualification for Bowls approved by the awards group OFQUAL.

The new qualification covers a number of topics including: Understanding the fundamentals of coaching sport, Understanding how to develop participant(s) through coaching sport, Supporting participant(s') lifestyle through coaching sport, Understanding the principles of safe and equitable coaching practice, Plan a series of bowls coaching sessions, Prepare the bowls coaching environment, Deliver a series of bowls coaching sessions and Monitor and evaluate bowls coaching sessions.

All candidates will be assessed following national assessment standards covering: The Role of a Sports Coach, Coaching and Learning Styles, Communication, Safeguarding Children and Vulnerable Adults, Equality and Diversity in Coaching Sport, Sports Science, Nutrition and Hydration, Drugs in Sport, Risk Assessment, Observed Coaching x 2, Coaching Outline Plan, Coaching Outline Plan 1 – 4 and Continuous Professional Development.

The cost of the full course is £150 per person, although the BDA are working with a number of partners to establish potential funding bursaries for coaches to assist with the cost.

Current Accredited Level 2 or even Level 3 coaches wishing to gain the new Qualification may do so by undertaking a bridging module. The bridging module will cost significantly less and will depend on your current coaching level.

If you are a current accredited Level 1 coach and wish to gain the Level 2 qualification then the new full Level 2 course is for you!

This is the recommended course for all bowls coaches and is being supported by Bowls England and English Indoor Bowling Association. In taking this Level 2 Qualification you will gain a qualification recognised by the sport, Local Authorities, County Sports Partnerships and other sports.
