Today marks the start of Disability Bowls August, a month-long promotion of disability bowls in England. Throughout August, the Bowls Development Alliance will be launching one press release per day relating to a range of initiative launches and topics including:

Disability Bowls August will also involve a showcase event on the 7<sup>th</sup> August at the Bowls England National Championships in Royal Learnington Spa where a Working with Disabled Bowlers module will be held followed by an exhibition match at 14:00 between a number of elite disabled bowlers, led by Disability Bowls England Chairman and Commonwealth Games Bronze Medallist, Paul Brown.
