Berkhamstead BC are committed to inclusive activity to such an extent that they have written into their constitution the importance of offering adaptive sessions in order to ensure that anybody can play bowls at their facilities.



The club are also proud of Sarah Marshall who is the current UK Blind Bowls Champion and Disability Games 2015 bronze medallist. A number of members have subsequently undertaken training to learn the "clock system" used to support visually impaired bowlers and the club boasts a number of coaches who run regular sessions for bowlers of all abilities, including specifically adaptive sessions.
