DRAMATIC FINISHES IN PAIRS QUARTER FINALS

as defending champions make great escape

When the quarter finals of the men's and women's pairs got underway at Melton tonight (WED), four of the pairs held hopes of repeating a previous triumph.

At the end of the evening three of those pairs are still in with a shout, but one of them, Lincoln's Danny Brown and Billy Jackson, who won the men's pairs in 2001, had dropped out of contention, after being beaten, 18-8, by the 2015 champions Mike Knight and Rob Newman, from the Whiteknights club in Reading.

In the women's event, defending champions Wendy King and Sandy Hazell, from the Swale club in Sittingbourne, survived a scare. Having trailed young hopefuls Katy and Lucy Smith, from Swindon's Westlecot club, 15-7 at ten ends, they showed what they are made of by clawing back to win, 19-17, breaking a 17-17 deadlock on the very last end.

And Blackpool Newton Hall duo Sue Kearsley and Janice Gower, who won the title in 2015, won by the same score against Julie Leake and Lyn Howard, from the Dolphin club in Poole. After establishing a 19-12 lead, the Lancastrians held on, and were happy to drop a treble and two singles on the last three ends.

In tomorrow's (THU) semi finals, the Blackpool duo will face a young Spalding pair, Ruby Hill and Chelsea Tomlin, who dashed the hopes of Chris Hobbs and Betty Spicer from the Arun club in Bognor Regis, 23-14. Holders Swale will play Egham's Kylie Hampton and Helen Tuohy, who edged home, 19-18, against City of Ely stars Joanne Denny and Sarah Seymour.

As for the men, Knight and Newman will take on Clarrie Dunbar's Russell Francis and Graham Shadwell, who ground out a 13-12 win over Mick Hawkins and Andy Walters, from Welford-on-Avon, while WBT World indoor singles champion Mark Dawes and his Blackpool Newton Hall clubmate Jonathan Goodall face local hopes Les Gillett and Chris Rodgers.

The Melton pair, with Gillett drawing to the jack with relentless accuracy, came through a tense tussle with City of Ely brothers Rob and Ed Elmore, winning 16-15, while the Blackpool pair defeated Hartlepool's Carl Higgins and Paul Hartley, 17-10.

Blackpool Newton Hall, of course, have their sights set on a double, with representatives in the semi finals of the men's and women's events tomorrow morning (THU).

HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE LAST SIXTEEN...

While the sport's legends were slugging it out this morning (WED) for places in the quarter finals of the national pairs championship in Melton Mowbray today, the EIBA's Director of Competitions, Carl Higgins, who has been working hard as Master of Ceremonies, took his place on the green alongside his Hartlepool clubmate Paul Hartley, and showed he can cut the mustard as a player.

"It's kind of difficult, because I haven't been able to practice for a week or so, and, of course, I have had my mind on other things," said Higgins. "But once I got out there, it didn't take me long to focus on the game."

Higgins and Hartley cleared the first hurdle, beating Andrew Rodger and Josh Pounds, from the Sittingbourne-based Swale club, 15-11, but lost in the quarter final to Goodall and Dawes.

England team captain Andy Thomson, from the Beckenham-based Cyphers club, was the biggest name to crash out in the last sixteen of the men's event, when he and Paul Field, with whom he won this title in 2009, were pipped by Russell Francis and Graham Shadwell, from the Clarrie Dunbar club in Somerset, 18-17.

In a closely contest match, it took a brilliant last bowl from Welford-on-Avon's Andy Walters to break a 16-16 deadlock and get past a Norfolk pair skipped by Wayne Willgress, 18-16. In what might be termed a family affair, Walters's wife Amy and Willgress's fiancée Bex had both qualified for the last sixteen in the women's pairs.

Both lost, Norfolk's Carole Baker and Bex Field going down by two shots to the Smith sisters, Katy and Lucy, from Westlecot, and Welford's Sue Davies and Amy Walters losing by four to Egham's Kylie Hampton and Helen Tuohy.

Torquay United's Cassidy Lenton and Harriet Stevens, still smarting from their defeat in yesterday's (TUE) triples final, dropped four shots on the last end to lose, 15-14, to Chris Hobbs and Betty Spicer, from the Arun club in Bognor Regis.
